New Features

The items in the list below are new features introduced with this release of Mobility Server. For further information on any of the below features please refer to product documentation that accompanies and is provided with this release.

Feature	Description
Tablet Support	Introduction of new Tablet device family with new device specific templates.
HTML 5 Support	Enables offline storage capability for touch and tablet family devices.
Bookmark DO	Adds 'app-like' bookmark icon on touch family devices for the mobile site on device home screen.
List Filter DO	Ability to filter different types of lists based on character string search.
Mapping Web Interface	Easy to use mapping GUI to make mapping assets easier.
Data Management Enhancements	RSS Source Type, Association Support, Inheritance Support
RSS Source Type	Enables mapping data from RSS and ATOM feeds to display objects for use on mobile site.
Association Support	Asset Associations in Content Server are reusable by Mobility Server.
Inheritance Support	Content Server asset hierarchy used to allow child assets to inherit attributes defined at the parent.

Known Limitations and Information

3795	Bug	Vertical bar scrolling with mouse on tablet causes iframe to move left and off screen. For workaround see <i>Special Instructions</i> section below.

3604	N/A	To add tablet lookups/ detection see <i>Special Instructions</i> section below.
3915	Bug	New oracle header bar logo image requires hard refresh to display properly after upgrade. See Special Instructions section below.
3884	Task	Many configuration settings in app.yml have been renamed. Please check for these entries in app.yml for both MobilityServer and MSAdmin and update as required. fatwire_* must be renamed to oraclecms_* fatwire_rest_uri must be renamed to cs_rest_uri
3803	Bug	Impacts some Android devices: listfilter text field shifts vertically when user tries to enter text.
3909	Bug	In certain situations, visitors returning online after viewing the offline version of the site will not be served full images in Detail DOs. The issue resolves itself as soon as the manifest is updated, which is typically any time a publishing operation occurs.

Special Instructions:

3795 - Tablet Family - Workaround for issue:

Resolve issue by setting the default zoom to either 100% or scroll up and down along the body of the body of the pane instead of the scroll bar itself.

3604 - Tablet Family - Upgrade Instructions:

If you have not made changes to your device family or detection rules, it is recommended that

you take backups of your filesystem and database, store your mappings to CS and then perform a fresh installation. Afterward, copy your template files and configuration back into place, run the relevant configuration tasks as described in the installation guide. The tablet family should then appear in MSAdmin.

If you have made changes to your device family detection rules (e.g. added a custom device family or moved a device from one family to another), please contact support to determine the best way to proceed.
